

What is a RevealSM Brow Lift?

RevealSM Brow Lift, also referred to as a forehead or eyebrow lift, allows patients to achieve a younger, more refreshed look by smoothing the forehead, reducing frown lines, and elevating the position of the eyebrow line to “open up the eyes”. This is accomplished by weakening the forehead muscles, removing excess skin that has lost its elasticity with age and lifting the skin to elevate and reposition brows.

Am I a good candidate for RevealSM Brow Lift surgery?

The best candidates are healthy adults who are seeking to improve droopy eyebrows and deeper, heavier wrinkles in the forehead.

What can I expect?

Surgery is performed using general anesthesia and typically lasts 2 hours (facility and anesthesia fees will apply).

There are two methods used in a RevealSM Brow Lift. In a traditional brow lift, an incision is made across the top of the forehead, behind the hair line. Through this incision, muscles in the forehead and between the eyes are weakened and excess skin and other tissues are removed in order to create a smooth, youthful-looking surface. In the last stage of the surgery, the forehead skin is elevated to lift the position of the eyebrow line and eliminate horizontal wrinkles. The initial brow lift incision is then carefully sutured closed.

The second method is an endoscopic brow lift, which is less invasive than the traditional brow lift surgery, resulting in less scarring, and reduced recovery time. The endoscopic brow lift is typically performed on patients who are younger and need a less extensive forehead and eyebrow lift.

How long is the recovery?

RevealSM Brow Lift recovery and results vary by individual, and depend on the type of lift being performed, and whether any other procedures are performed in conjunction with the brow lift.

Post-operative discomfort can usually be controlled with over-the-counter medication, and most patients can return to their normal daily activities in about 2 weeks and may resume exercise after 4 weeks.

Because the endoscopic brow lift technique requires smaller incisions and does not necessitate significant skin removal, recovery time is reduced.

What are the risks associated with RevealSM Brow Lift?

RevealSM Brow Lift complications may include issues that are common potential problems for all surgery: bleeding, infection, hematoma, adverse reactions to anesthesia and scarring. Though rare, skin and nerve damage, and hair loss are also risks to consider.

What type of scarring should I expect?

Because the incisions are made on the scalp inside the hair line, they will not be visible.
